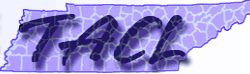

Please fill out the application on the adjoining page and return to the Hardin County Chamber of Commerce by July 1, 2011.

Please type or print in the space provided. Successful applicants need to be involved in their communities and have demonstrated leadership or potential for leadership in Hardin County. Be sure your application identifies these leadership characteristics in order that the selection committee can give your application full consideration. Attaching a brief bio is recommended.

Leadership Hardin County participants are selected without regard to sex, race, age, national origin, or handicap status.



PARTICIPANT COMMITMENT

Time Commitment:

Certificates of completion will be presented to those successfully completing the program. It is expected that all participants will attend all of the monthly functions, agree to complete any assigned meetings, and commit to working with your team on your class project. No more than one monthly function can be missed in order to graduate. Participants who miss more will be asked to make up the missed sessions and graduate the following year.

Tuition and Funding:

Tuition for the 6 month program is \$175 per participant, with a class limit of 20 participants. Participants will pay his/her fee or have a sponsor. Fees include meals, materials and a banquet ticket to the graduation ceremony.

Selection for Leadership Hardin County:

The most important factor in selection is identifying those individuals most apt to utilize their leadership for the long-term benefit of the community.

Impact:

Leadership Hardin County program provides participants with a chance to increase their awareness of the strengths and major issues facing Hardin County. Equally valuable is the opportunity to become acquainted with people from all areas of the county, to listen to their opinions, and to share a concern for Hardin County.

The program's full impact may not be effectively measured for many years, until alumni reach their full potential in their respective fields. Many alumni have already advanced to positions of greater responsibility within their corporations, organizations and within the community.

It is believed that the individual and combined efforts of Leadership Hardin County's graduates will continue to strengthen the county.

Class Schedule

Class sessions will begin in July and consist of 6 monthly functions featuring:

- Government.....July
- Tourism.....August
- Education.....September
- Agricultural.....October
- Industry.....November
- Healthcare.....December

Each function will involve panel discussions, group discussions, field trips, lectures, interviews with community leaders, community meetings and opportunities to learn about Hardin County.

The conclusion of the program will be a graduation ceremony at the Chamber’s annual banquet.
